

## WICHITA EAST, MT. HOPE WIN STATE TRACK TITLES

### FOUR NEW MARKS ESTABLISHED; INDEPENDENCE, WICHITA NORTH, WYANDOTTE ANNEX GOLF, TENNIS HONORS

After a lapse of nine years, Wichita East regained the state track supremacy among Class A schools at the state high school track and field meet held at Emporia on May 19 and 20. Mount Hope replaced Hugoton as the champion in the Class B division, established for the first time last year.

Four new records were established, two being in the discus with the introduction of the new lightweight platter. Willmar Bledsoe, Great Bend, smashed the oldest mark when he leaped 23 ft. 2 in. to eclipse the broad jump record of 22 ft. 11<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> in. set by Papin, Iola, in 1933. George Benson, Hutchinson, boosted the bar in the pole vault to a new high of 12 ft. 4<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> in. for another Class A record. The former mark was 12 ft. 4 in. held jointly by Perry, Wichita East, and Bird, Arkansas City, since 1934.

Douglas McEnulty, Wichita East, tossed the lighter discus 145 ft. 10 in. for a new Class A mark, while Martin Gorby, Rock Creek, chalked up 136 ft. 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> in. for a Class B record. Bunsen, Shawnee Mission, set the previous Class A record with the heavier discus in 1937 when he turned in a mark of 135 ft. 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> in. White, Pleasanton, had the best earlier Class B mark with a toss of 134 ft. 9<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> in. in 1930.

A record entry list of 53 Class A schools and 93 Class B schools participated in the 1939 meet. Thirty-two Class A schools figured in the scoring, while 57 Class B schools were represented in the point total. Points were awarded for five places for the first time.
