

TWO NEW TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONS

Wichita East Repeats As Class AA Champion; Kingman Annexes Class A Title; Coldwater New Class B Title Holder; New Records in Mile; Discus and Class A 880-Yard Run

Wichita East annexed its sixth track and field championship in eight years in the Class AA division of the state meet held at Kansas State College, Manhattan, on May 19 and 20. East had a total of 64½ points to finish far ahead of second-place Wyandotte and third-place Topeka, with totals of 30 and 27½ points respectively.

Kingman edged Stafford 22 7/10 to 22 for the Class A title. Ellis had a total of 15 points to rank third in this division.

Coldwater outdistanced the field in the Class B schools with a total of 25 points, followed by second-place Bogue with 16 and Immaculata of Leavenworth with 15.

Two new state records were established and a new mark set in the Class B 880-yard run. Kiowa's Bill Tidwell scored the upset of the day when he defeated the mile favorite Wesley Santee of Ashland to establish a new record in the mile of 4:27.1. This betters the Glenn Cunningham mark of 4:28.4 set in 1930. Big Jesse Priscock of Emporia hurled the discus 158 feet ¾ inches to beat the former record of 156 feet and 6½ inches set by Knight of Salina in 1945. Arthur Dalzell of Spring Hill ran the 880 in 1:59.6 to eclipse the record of 1:59.7 in the Class B division. Sandefur of Stafford and McGlenn of Immaculata both bettered the existing Class A and B marks in the 220-yard dash, but wind conditions kept their marks from being accepted.

The weather was cloudy most of the day, with heavy rain falling during the last few events of the meet.

Wichita East, Independence Take Golf Title

Wichita East dominated play in the state grass greens golf tournament held at Manhattan Country Club on May 19-20 by winning medalist honors and both the two-man and four-man team championships. Independence also took the three top honors in the sand greens tournament held at Junction City Country Club on the same dates.

Bob Goetz of East took the medalist title with a total score of 146 for the 36 holes of play. Don Nichols of Auburn was runner-up for the second straight year with a score of 150. Goetz teamed with John Prosser with a total of 306 for the two-man championship. Hise and Heidenreich of Shawnee Mission had a 318 to win second place honors in the two-man field. In the four-man division, East's Goetz, Prosser, Bowden and Donovan had a total score of 644 for first place honors. Shawnee Mission's team of Hise, Heidenreich, Peterson and Stretcher had a total score of 650 for the runner-up position in the four-man totals.

David Runyan of Independence and Dale Howell of Larned tied for the medalist title in the sand greens tournament at Junction City, each shooting a 145 for the 36 holes. Carter and Dye of Independence each had a score of 149 to place third in individual play. Carter and Runyan's 294 was low in the two-man field with Howell and Holman pushing them hard for the first-place honors with a score of 295. Runyan, Carter, Allen and Dye of Independence outdistanced all competition in the four-man division by a comfortable margin with a total
