### Regulations For Cross Country

Regulations now provide that cross country practice may not start before the opening of school in the fall and shall terminate with the state meet. No student or team representing a member high school shall participate in more than seven cross country meets during a season, exclusive of the regional and state meets.

## Wichita East, Herington and Ashland New State Track Champions

There was little team competition in the State Track Field Championships held May 19 and 20 at the University of Wichita as Wichita East, Herington and Ashland walked off from rivals in the Class AA, A and B divisions respectively. Ten new records were set in the two-day meet held under excellent weather conditions.

Each of the team champions was paced by outstanding sprinters in Wichita East's junior Bob Hanson, Herington's Jim Perry and Bob McNickle of Ashland. All three dash men won first places in their three individual events. Hanson won the 100 yard dash, 220 dash, and 180 yard low hurdles, and anchored East's winning 880 yard relay team. Perry copped the high hurdles, 100 yard dash and low hurdles. For McNickle it was first places in the 100, 220 and 440 yard dashes.

The Topeka High School Trojan's four-man team of Scott Linscott, Bay Chotlos, Bill McDonald and John Stinson had little competition as they shot a combined total score of 622 compared to second-place Arkansas City with 648. Andy Nusbaum and J. Haase of Salina won the two-man grass greens championship by topping their nearest competitors, Manhattan, by 14 strokes.
