*Resident Throws and Pole Vault Coach –
USATF OTC – Chula Vista, CA*

Ty Sevin is a graduate of Texas A&M and a former 2-time NCAA All-American Javelin Thrower. Ty was a member of three National Teams and a 2 time Olympic Trials Qualifier, finishing 5th in the 2000 trials.

His best javelin throw in college was 248-10 and his best career javelin throw was 263, which ranks as the 11th all-time best in U.S. history.

Sevin's post-collegiate career took the Louisiana native down the path of coaching. Ty held assistant coaching positions at Texas A&M, Oklahoma State, and Michigan State before taking over as the Head Coach at McNeese State in 2005.

Ty Sevin is now the Resident Throws and Pole Vault Coach at the Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista, CA.
